Traveling Clinic: October 24/25
Follow-Up Clinic: November 1

GET THE FLU SHOT – NOT THE FLU

Continuing with our annual flu clinics, we will be offering the seasonal flu vaccination to district staff this year. Please circulate and post the schedule, and advise all staff at your site, including crosswalk guards, noon-hour supervisors, itinerant staff, TOC's and casual employees. A signed and dated consent form must be submitted to the provider before the vaccines will be administered (attached).

Same as last year, Shoppers Drug Mart pharmacists will be administering the flu vaccine at our school sites. Since 2009, pharmacists have been granted the authority to administer certain immunizations, including the flu vaccine, to BC residents over the age of five. Pharmacists also have access to the publicly-funded flu vaccine. BC residents who meet eligibility criteria set out by the BC Center of Disease Control can get the flu vaccine free of charge. Previously, the District paid for each flu shot administered.

Attached to this memo is the eligibility criteria; if you meet one of criteria on the list, check the box at the bottom of the form, then sign and date it and bring it with you, along with the signed and dated consent form, to the pharmacist when you receive the flu shot (there is no need to identify which of the criteria applies to you). If none of the criteria applies to you, you can still receive a flu shot.

This year's vaccine provides protection against the following strains of influenza:

1. A/Michigan/45/2015 (H1N1)pdm09-like strain
2. A/Hong Kong/4801/2014 (H3N2)-like strain
3. B/Brisbane/60/2008-like strain


The pharmacists will start the clinic at the time and location at the top of the list for each day, and work through the sites. Please ensure there is a space available for them to use. They will call ahead when they are ready to leave each site with an expected arrival time at the next site on the list. Please do not expect the pharmacist to wait for recess or lunch to administer the injections.

Arrival times on the schedule are APPROXIMATE, based on the results from last year, and are subject to change depending on the demand.

For your convenience, the schedule and consent forms will be posted in FirstClass under **All Staff/District Programs/Occ Health & Safety**.
